

# Suggested Items To Bring To Florida

## 1 – medium/large size suitcase (NOT SUPERSIZE - no more than 50 pounds)

All student luggage to-be-checked will be dropped off Friday 4/22 between 5-7pm in the PHS Bandroom.

Bags will be subject to random searches by police and the canine unit. Liquid/gel items (such as shampoos, makeup, toothpaste, large bottles of sunscreen, etc.) should be pre-packed in your checked luggage.

- Comfortable clothes for 1 week (it will be 90+ degrees all week)
- Appropriate sleepwear for 7 nights
- Sunscreen/Sunglasses/Hat
- Cell Phone & Charger
- Swimwear (for hotel pool)

## 1 – regulation-size carry-on (must fit under seat or in overhead bin)

All carry-on luggage should be brought on Sunday evening.

Reminder that in addition to scanning, all carry-on items are subject to random searches at the terminal.

*You can bring a refillable water bottle through airport screening provided it is empty. Once through TSA screening, you can fill it at airport water filling stations. This will also come in handy at the parks and save you \$\$.*

**Remember that your luggage will be waiting for you at the hotel when you arrive, so your carry-on items should be limited to only what you need for the airport wait & flight, nothing else.**

\*\*\*If you must pack liquids in your carry-on (ie: contact solution, sunscreen, etc) PLEASE NOTE –

1. All liquids, gels and aerosols must be in three-ounce or smaller containers. Larger containers that are half-full or toothpaste tubes rolled up are not allowed. **Each container must be three ounces or smaller.**
2. All liquids, gels and aerosols must be placed in a single, quart-size, zip-top, clear plastic bag. Gallon size bags or bags that are not zip-top such as fold-over sandwich bags are not allowed. **Each traveler can use only one, quart-size, zip-top, clear plastic bag.**
3. Each traveler must remove their quart-sized plastic, zip-top bag from their carry-on and place it in a bin or on the conveyor belt for X-ray screening. X-raying separately will allow TSA security officers to more easily examine the declared items.
4. If your items don't match these regulations, you will have to throw them away at the security checkpoint.
5. Save yourself the trouble and pack these items in the luggage for the truck and not your airline carry-on.

## Band Instrument/Equipment/Music

## Band Uniform(s) & all accessories (t-shirts & black socks)

Will be loaded on the truck Friday afternoon

## What NOT To Bring

- Anything that you cannot fit into your suitcase or carry-on
- Please leave the video game console systems at home
- Large amounts of cash (students should give to a chaperone/staff member to hold)
- If you can't bring "it" to school, you should not bring it on the trip.
